### **Motion**

Motion: That an Ad-Hoc committee be formed for the purpose of preparing and presenting a 2009 IRCNA Bid Package. The bid shall contain but not be limited to all necessary information required for bid submittals, as outlined by the Convention Standing Board of the Iowa Regional Service Committee. The IRCNA Bid Package shall be presented at the February Regional by the ad-hoc committee participants.

**Intent:** In spirit of humility, the hopes of being awarded the honor of hosting the Iowa Convention to be held in the summer of 2009.

**Background:** The SCANA area last hosted the IRCNA in 1999 in Ames. IRCNA was also held in Des Moines in 1994 and in 1988. Though our bid was not awarded a few years ago, we feel that confident that our time has come. There is already a marked interest in seeing this Convention come to our area. The following members met informally on Sept. 29 with the desire to see this convention come to our area. Kat O., Jennifer M., Pat D., Rick L.S., Stacy W. and Calvin H. We are committed to working closely with the Standing Committee to be sure that all requirements for the Bid Package are met. Our hope is to be awarded the hosting of the 2009 convention and all the benefits that come with the hard work involved in putting on this Regional Convention. If awarded this convention, we will do our very best to chose those trusted servants that best exemplify experience, integrity, humility and the spirit of service necessary to hold leadership or treasury positions on a convention committee.

### **Of Interest:**

- IRCNA will be February 2009. It was discussed that we should have a standing committee, just an informal committee to talk about it. It would give unity to this area and we need good leadership. We need to submit it for the February Region. We need to ask the fellowship, “Do **We** want to do it?” The Motion was tabled. We have to have G.S.R. Policy approval.
- Nominations for positions are as follows: Vice Chair – Matt J., Treasurer – Mark A.M., Co-Treasurer – Robbie E., Secretary – Wanda P., R.C.M. Alt., Pat D., Jennifer M., and Jeanie W.
- 5 corrections from the last minutes: the closing balance was \$1,951.16 as it was left at 0’s. Also it should have said that Activities has \$400.00 to spend, not \$1,000. Several in the group thought that P.I. felt that they didn’t get their fair share last year with the \$ available for

spending, not this year. Jon L. said his name was spelt wrong and Victoria denies stating that she said to get to the Regional meeting and vote this year, and asked that it be corrected in the minutes. She also asked that her number be put on the minutes with the other officer's #'s. Sorry for any errors or misunderstandings.

- New 1/4 report is on the table. We spent \$200.00 more than we put in.
- Complaints of the Vice Chair "hasn't done ½ his job for ½ of the year." The Vice Chair did call Deb @ 9 a.m. this morning. People in the fellowship discussed if they wanted to vote him on as Chair or not. Discussion followed. It was discussed that we need improving with our leadership, and the Vice Chair had not gone to any sub committees for the last 6 months. The mail had not been picked up twice a month like it should and the Treasurer is supposed to have a second key and doesn't. It was decided to motion to table it until next month, and wait for Tim D. to be present, during elections anyway. More will be revealed.
- Tim N. has volunteered to attend the business meetings until a new G.S.R. takes his place. That is for the Wednesday, Recovery on the River – at the Y. M. C. A. downtown. He is looking to take a break from the program and further his recovery within his church.
- Jon L. asks for any women with substantial clean time to please come to the Sunday Night 7 p.m. meeting at Broad lawns hospital as women there are in need of finding a sponsor and not too many women attend that meeting at this time.
- Alicia E. is also requesting people to help out and become trusted servants for the Truth or Consequences meetings weekly. This is located at South Ridge Mall off Army Post Road.
- Robbie E. declined nominations for Vice Chair, due to problems, but accepted the position of Co. Treasurer. It was discussed at this time that no clean time requirements are posted for co-treasurer, but there is a desire put it into policy that 5 – 7 years of clean time be required for this position. Tya and Deb also both declined nominations. Jeanie W. will be stepping out of her nomination as Regional Alt. due to her circumstances at this time as she is choosing to step back from several service positions for a while. All nominations were closed at this time.
- The group discussed pros and cons regarding hearing qualifications for leadership positions and acting appropriately. Also talked of following Robert's Rules of Order as a system to govern, as some N.A. fellowships (In California) are trying alternate ways of governing their Area. They also talked of making a commitment and sticking to it. We talked about conflicts and how we can go to sub committee meetings about them.
- Deb B. talked with Matt J. about taking on the position of Vice Chair. Could he handle it if the Chair does not show up, people may become obnoxious and could he handle it and deal with it without raising your voice or becoming angry. Could he conduct himself without letting his emotions get in the way? He shared that as an umpire in his private life and a high school official in his job he has to be calm. He feels that there is always a right way and a wrong way to deal with situations. He said obviously "no cussing" because that is just not appropriate. He feels sometimes the place is just full of controversy. He states, "Where I am in my recovery – I have gotten a lot better. I can handle delicate or in your face confrontations. I believe I can handle it well and appropriately." Deb also informed him that the position of Vice Chair requires you to be there from 9 – 6 p.m. at Area. She asked him, "are you willing to be of service like that if need be? And can you get the mail twice per month and remain anonymous when you should?" He felt certain he could follow through.

- Mark A.M. shared that his clean date was December 27, 2000 and that his sponsor was wanting him to get involved at an Area level. He shared that he wanted to renew his recovery and jump back in. He is working the steps daily. He was asked about his experience pertaining to the treasurer position and he explained that he has done book keeping at a previous job where he was a manager of a gas station. He has done record keeping also. When asked about personality conflicts he stated that he would conduct himself in a better manner. He truly believes that he can do this position. He doesn't know Excel but he understands that things do take time to learn and he is willing to do that.
- Robbie E. was asked various questions about the position of Co-Treasurer. He states that he knows how to balance a check book and knows the Excel software well. He has great ideas on how to work together with the Treasurer in order to get things taken care of in a timely and efficient manner. He is willing to teach the Treasurer skills that he knows. He blew up four years ago when he was on the committee and he was asked about his temper and flare ups. He stated that in the past year he has had only 4 outbursts. One was at Tya and another female and the other 2 times was at his own kid. He said he has improved greatly in the area. He feels he will act in a proper manner and believes he can provide effective leadership. He said he is ready to step up to the plate and act accordingly.
